Nutcracker Performance Day Info

The only classes at the Studio the week of DECEMBER 12th will be MONDAY night classes. All other classes (Tues-Thurs) will be made up the week prior to the show. ALL Students involved in the Nutcracker do not need to make up classes as they will be rehearsing and at the stage rehearsing that week anyway!

Performance Day Check-list and To Do's:

All Students must arrive on time

Students must arrive with Make-up and Hair completed

Students may leave once show has finished and curtain is closed. Not before!

General Notes will be announced at the beginning of the show days and at dress rehearsals.

Keeping a Schedule is very Important!

No food or colored drinks back stage.

Water is allowed

Manners and respect must be shown by all dancers, quick changers and room mothers.

Room mothers- will meet with Miss Anna prior to Show day to go over rules, regulations and backstage info.

Badges for Helpers must be worn backstage for privacy and protection of our dancers.

No one other than Mothers, Sisters, Grandmas, Aunts or Women helpers may be backstage at any time.

No student is allowed to leave backstage unless the parent or Guardian has come and addressed the room mother
ENCOURAGEMENT AND FUN must be shown by all!!

Saturday Show Day - December 17th

Arrive to the Theatre- 4:30 p.m.- Doors open at 6- Show begins 6:30 (EARLIER THIS YEAR)

TINIEST DANCERS—Candies-may arrive NO LATER THAN 5p.m.- FULL HAIR AND MAKE UP DONE.

Sunday Show Day-December 18th

Arrive to the Theatre- 12:30 p.m. - Doors open to public at 1:30- Show begins 2:00

Please know the call time is early because I review with students, make sure costumes are ok, dancers need to warm-up and class rooms and moms need to be situated prior to show doors opening. Stage is cleared at opening of doors and Dancers are to be prepped and feeling ready at that time. This allows for all emergencies to be taken care before show start. Thank you
